



MULTI-ENGINE CLASS RATING - AEROPLANE

PRIVILEGES:

Adds the privilege of flying multi-engine aeroplane to the Private or Commercial Pilot Licence.

FLIGHT TRAINING:

There are no minimum flight training requirements for this rating. Applicants must meet a certain level of proficiency.

MEDICAL FITNESS:

An applicant shall hold a valid category 3 or category 1 medical certificate.

GROUND SCHOOL TRAINING:

A Multi-Engine Class Rating applicant does not require an approved ground school, however due to the advanced nature of the training a technical ground school provided by Durham Flight Centre covering all aspects of the Tecnam P2006T will be required.

WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

A Durham Flight Centre multi-engine open and closed book exam for the Tecnam P2006T is required.

FLIGHT TEST:

A flight test is required.



COURSE ENROLLMENT:

Students may enroll at any time and commence flight training at their convenience.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

Prerequisites: Private or Commercial Pilot Licence
Category 3 or Category 1 Medical Fitness

Age: 17 years of age or older.

Citizenship: Must be a Canadian citizen, a landed immigrant, or person admitted into Canada to undertake flight training.

Language: Must be able to read, write, and speak in English without assistance.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Durham Flight Centre operates on a "pay as you fly" basis for flight training, thus no up-front payments are required. Payment is based on hourly rates and will be paid after the completion of each lesson.

COST BREAKDOWN:

The following cost breakdown is based on the average Durham Flight Centre student. The actual cost could vary with individual progress or needs.

• 7 Hours Dual Flight Instruction	\$3,500.00
• 3 Hours Pre-flight Preparatory Instruction	\$270.00
• Ground School	\$500.00
• Transport Canada Flight Test Aircraft Rental (1.5 Flight Time)	\$615.00
• Total Cost*	\$4,885.00

The above costs do not include HST.

*The total cost does not include additional fees that may be incurred during flight training such as flight test fees, licencing fees, etc.
